With each color someone that has passed on from a life which deeply impacted our community is attached: Pedro Zamora, Assotto Saint, Brenda Howard, Ruth Ellis, Leslie Cheung, and Sylvia Rivera. We have a rainbow of various flowers of people in the LGBT community. Pieces of that diversity (ethnic culture, ability, gender, orientation, age, time periods, etc.) was taken from a pantheon of incredible people that has dedicated parts of their lives to our culture and movement. So know when you choose a level that it has meaning, a deep meaning, to our community.
